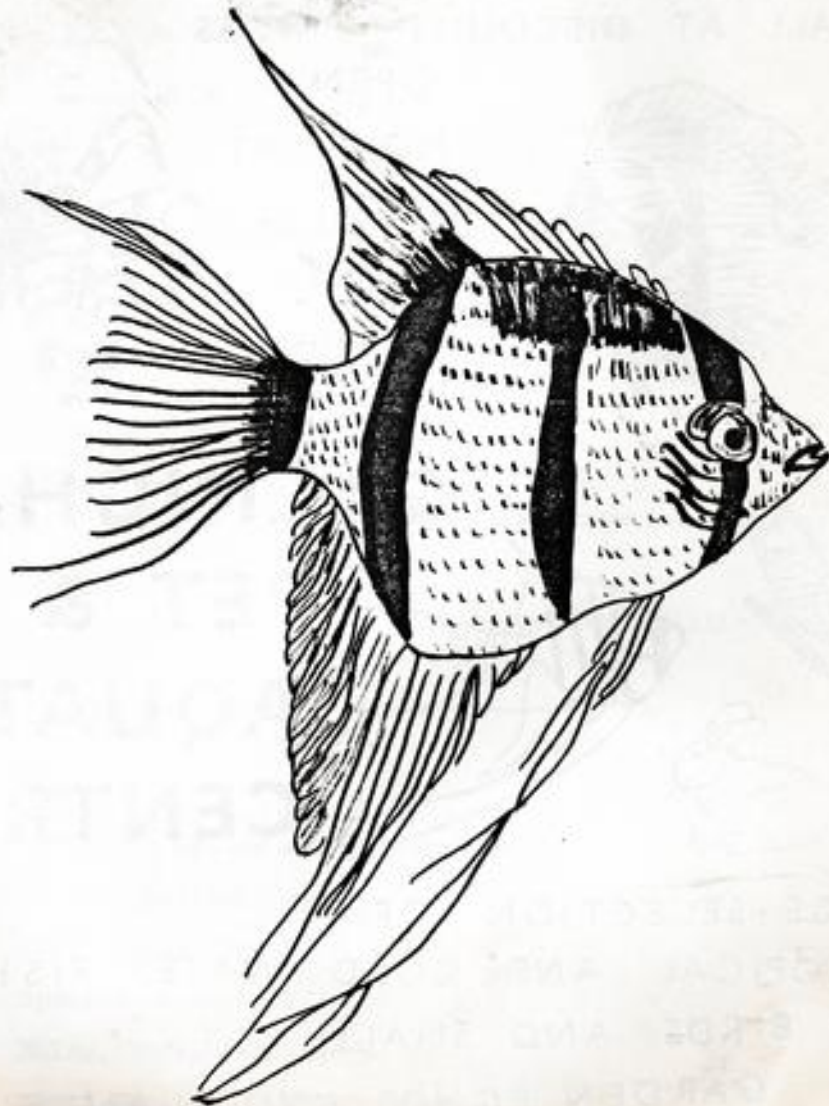

LAMPROLOGUS BRICHARDI

This cichlid, named after Frenchman Paul Brichard, comes from Lake Tanganyika. It grows to about 4" and is very slow growing, it suits our area as it likes fresh hard water at 75 - 78F.

They are hard to sex out as young fish and is best if 3 or 4 are bought to enable them to pick their own mates, they usually then bully the others and the male can be very vicious especially at breeding time and they are best kept as a pair in separate tanks.

They lay eggs usually on a previously cleaned stone. The eggs will hatch in about 30 - 36 hours depending on the temperature, and the female then hides her brood in hollows in the gravel or behind rocks, allowing them to swim freely after 6 or 7 days. The best food for the young is newly hatched brine shrimp, the adults will eat dried food, but much prefer live food or small amount of beef heart, also squashed peas and spinach in small amounts will be accepted.

I think this a very attractive cichlid and also interesting fish.
